## ABOUT 7 ELITE ACADEMY



7 Elite Academy is a global youth soccer academy that runs teams and educational programs for thousands of young people in the United States, United Kingdom and East Africa.

Using a Global Development Plan prepared by professional coaches with experience of the world's biggest leagues, players receive an elite level of coaching and personal development.

7 Elite Academy places key emphasis on ensuring players have the best opportunities to reach their true potential in soccer, education and service projects within their communities. Players regularly graduate from 7 Elite Academy to study at some of the biggest colleges in the United States, as well as professional clubs and academies in Liverpool - the global home of soccer.

The links between 7 Elite Academy teams in Liverpool and Utah mean players regularly travel between the two locations to play in tournaments and study at leading colleges.

7 Elite Academy also stages a huge annual youth soccer tournament in Southern Utah and Nevada, with 500 teams registered from the USA and the UK in 2024.





7 Elite Academy was formed in 2017 and has since developed a proud reputation for training young people to achieve their best potential in soccer and elsewhere in their lives.

From just a few teams in Salt Lake City, it has built strong foundations with professional clubs and academies across the world, as well and colleges and universities. Since it was opened in 2018, our indoor facility in Salt Lake City has expanded to become a true hotbed of youth soccer coaching throughout the year.

In 2018, the 7 Elite Academy 01 Boys South were crowned National Champions at the Presidents Cup and helped set in motion a remarkable period of expansion. In fact, as the largest academy in Southern Utah, we now coach hundreds of players across all age groups at locations in St George and Washington, alongside a burgeoning Pre-Academy program.

The 7 Elite Academy International Tournament was launched in 2018, when just over 40 teams from Utah took part. By 2024, that number had increased to 500 teams registered from across the world at venues in St George, Washington and Mesquite. Players, families and coaches generated over \$1,000,000 of additional income in those towns during the three-day event.

In 2019, 7 Elite Academy UK was launched in Liverpool with two teams at Under-11 and Under-13 level. Months later, our UK Academy signed a ground-breaking partnership agreements with local senior club. AFC Liverpool.

That agreement has seen 7 Elite Academy UK players compete in the FA Youth Cup, the most famous youth soccer competition in the world. In 2020, they took on and beat Wrexham FC - Ryan Reynolds included!

Today, 18 teams represent 7 Elite Academy in the UK at all age levels. Tuesday night Pre-Academy sessions at the organization's dedicated training base are sold out weeks in advance! Links between the UK and USA have proved invaluable in creating new opportunities for players to reach their true potential. Thanks to our Player Pathway, countless young people now study and train overseas.

Recently we saw Harrison O'Brien – a player from our under 13s in the UK - sign a contract with Premier League giants, Liverpool FC! In 2023, we saw FIVE players travel from Utah to train with the famous Steven Gerrard Academy in Liverpool. Countless others achieved their ambition of being offered college scholarships.

From just a few teams in Salt Lake City in 2017, 7 Elite Academy has embarked on an unforgettable journey of expansion and progress and is now one of the premier youth academies in Utah. We have also had two of our coaches in the past 4 years be named as 'Coach of the Year' for the state of Utah.

# ABOUT THE UNITED KINGDOM

7 Elite Academy runs teams, training programs and educational projects for 18 teams in the heart of Liverpool, one of the greatest soccer cities in the world. From a dedicated training base at Litherland Sports Park, players from Under-6 to Under-18 levels enjoy weekly training sessions with dedicated and highly qualified coaching staff.

7 Elite Academy teams compete in some of the best youth leagues in the country, including the Junior Premier League and Liverpool County Premier League. Every week, Player Pathway sessions give players in younger age groups an opportunity to get a fun introduction to soccer. Those sessions have proved so popular that they are now sold-out weeks in advance!

An exclusive partnership with AFC Liverpool means players now have a recognised route from those younger age groups through to senior football and beyond. Players are now seeing the fruits of that relationship, with recent graduate Josh Miles having signed a three-year professional contract with Blackpool in League One.







Partnerships with local colleges and professional academies in Liverpool mean other players are now also embarking on the journey from the UK to college soccer in the United States.

Regular tours of the United States and Europe to play in college showcase events have played a key role in preparing those young people for the rigours of college life.

In 2024, we saw over 70 UK-based players take part in the 7 Elite Academy International Tournament in Utah and Nevada, before a series of games against La Liga club Villarreal in Las Vegas.

7 Elite Academy UK may be based in Liverpool, but its links with clubs and colleges worldwide make it a key part of our truly global academy network.

Those games were watched by scouts from colleges and professional clubs across the world, including - amongst many others - Utah Tech, Real Salt Lake and Steven Gerrard Academy.

The presence of so many teams, coaches and families proved to be a huge boost for the local economies in Southern Utah and Nevada. Hotels and restaurants were booked out weeks in advance. In fact, it is estimated that the three-day tournament created well over \$1,000,000 of additional income for businesses in the host towns and cities.



#### 7 Elite Academy Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct:

Youth football programs serve as vital platforms for fostering the physical, social, and emotional growth of children. Therefore, it is imperative for parents, coaches, spectators, and officials to promote the values of good sportsmanship among youth athletes. Additionally, those involved in youth sports events should exemplify good sportsmanship and lead by example, demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control.

7 Elite Academy has devised this code of conduct to uphold a standard of good sportsmanship and conduct within our organization. It is essential for our staff, players, and players' families to commit to these principles. We ask that you pledge to take responsibility for your words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in all youth football events, as well as any associated communication channels such as social media outlets. By joining 7 Elite Academy you are agreeing to do the following:

Encourage good sportsmanship by consistently showing positive support for all players, coaches, officials, opponents, and staff. I/We agree to conduct ourselves responsibly and respectfully, displaying sportsmanlike behavior before, during, and after any activity associated with 7EA.

Prioritize the emotional and physical well-being of my/our child/minor and other participants over personal agendas or desires to win. I/We will emphasize that the primary purpose of the activity is enjoyment and participant benefit, rather than parental or guardian satisfaction. I/We understand that playing time is determined by coaching staff based on various factors, and no guarantee of specific minutes on the pitch during games is implied.

Ensure that my child/minor and I/We treat all players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect, regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability. I/We commit to being role models by actively supporting all participants and refraining from engaging in discriminatory, derogatory, disrespectful, or unsportsmanlike behavior.

Ensure punctuality for my child's attendance at all practices, games, and other 7 Elite Academy events.

Never prioritize winning over the safety and welfare of others. I/We will take accountability for any actions that violate this code of conduct by my child/minor, or by any guests or relatives of attending parents/guardians.

Provide constructive feedback on my child's team program to the head coach and/or 7 Elite Academy staff at appropriate times and through proper channels. I will strive for positive outcomes for all involved and adhere to club guidelines by posing questions regarding my child's or their coaches' performance no sooner than 24 hours after practice or the game.

Respect the authority of game officials (including coaches) and accept their decisions during matches. I/We understand that officials oversee all games, and their decisions are final. I/We will refrain from interfering with coaching staff during games or practices and will not protest a game official's decision in a manner that may incite aggressive behavior.

Abstain from possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, vaping/electronic tobacco products, illegal substances, or similar items on practice or playing fields, or in the presence of team gatherings at any activity.

Maintain a respectful distance behind the designated 'spectator respect barrier' or ground markings during games and practices.

Refrain from encouraging or coercing players from opposing teams to join my child's team or enticing any players from my child's team to join another team.

#### Online Conduct:

While the internet serves as a valuable tool for disseminating information, it can also facilitate misuse, abuse, and misconduct. At no time shall a 7 Elite Academy player, parent, or any individual post negative or derogatory messages or comments related to football on online platforms such as chat rooms, blogs, social media channels, etc. Such behavior is unacceptable and may tarnish the reputation and integrity of the individual, their family, and 7 Elite Academy. 7 Elite Academy's marketing team will monitor these platforms to the best of their ability.

Failure to adhere to the prevailing code of conduct during youth football events may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to:

- Verbal warning issued by an official, team coach, or 7 Elite Academy representative.
- Written warning issued by 7 Elite Academy.
- Suspension or immediate ejection from a youth football event by 7 Elite Academy.
- Removal from the 7 Elite Academy team and organization.
